To the Honorable The Mayor and Council City of San Diego, California.

Gentlemen:

We are enclosing herewith Resolution ratifying, confirming and approving the lease between The City of San Diego and the American Products, Inc., on a piece of property near the Foot of 7th Street. They propose to operate a wholesale lumber yard. The proposed lease to run for a period of fifteen (15) years at the following rental rate:

For the first five (5) years of the term of said lease, at the rate of one cent (1 c) per square foot per year;

For the second five (5) years, at a rate to be fixed by the Harbor Commission, which rate shall be not less than two cents $(2\not e)$ per square foot per year, and not to exceed four cents $(4\not e)$ per square foot per year;

For the last five (5) year period of said term, at a rate to be fixed by the Harbor Commission, which rate shall be not less than four cents (4ϕ) per square foot per year, and not to exceed six cents (6ϕ) per square foot per year.
