San Diego, Calif.

Gentlemen:

San Diego City Ordinance 7621 granting to the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company permission to construct, operate and maintain a system of spur tracks across and along certain streets and municipal tide lands in said city.

The above ordinance grants to this company a franchise to construct spur tracks across Laurel, Atlantic and Juniper Streets, and over and across a portion of the municipal tide lands, and upon and along Belt Street, in your city.

At the time of the granting of this ordinance it was the intention of this company to serve the various canning companies as outlined, but we have now decided that the same end can be accomplished, and on a more economical basis, by having the ordinance amended as follows:

Main Lead Spur Tracks: The center line of this track to follow the same course as outlined in the ordinance.

Spurs "A" and "B": In the plans now to be followed it will not be necessary to construct these spurs and they should be eliminated from the ordinance.


Spur "C": Beginning at a point in the center line of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's main lead spur track at Engineer's Station 14, plus 57.96 feet, said point being 68.66 feet southerly from the Southern line

attached hereto showing location of our proposed spur "D".

We will appreciate it very much if your Honorable Body will expedite the enactment of the changes out-lined above, inasmuch as it is our desire to rush the con-struction all possible in order that we may be in a position to handle all shipments incident to this year's pack as expeditiously as possible.
