SPECIFICATIONS:

Display to read "BROADWAY PIER" in sheet metal skeleton type letters 48 inches high, these letters to have red Neon tubes superimposed over the face.

The cost of this sign would be about \$40.00 per month for three years and would include the following items, building, installing and maintenance for three years as well as the cost of electricity and taxes and insurances.

Items covered under maintenance would include cleaning and repainting at regular intervals, all breakage and worn out parts repaired, in fact everything that would be necessary to keep it looking and operating 100% at all times.

At the expiration of the three year term the sign would become the property of the City of San Diego, at which time, should the city desire a maintenance contract it could be obtained at approximately \$10.00 per month.

The city would be under no obligation for any part of the above, the entire expense, even including current consumption to be paid by the lessee.
