To the Honorable, the Common Council, San Diego, California:

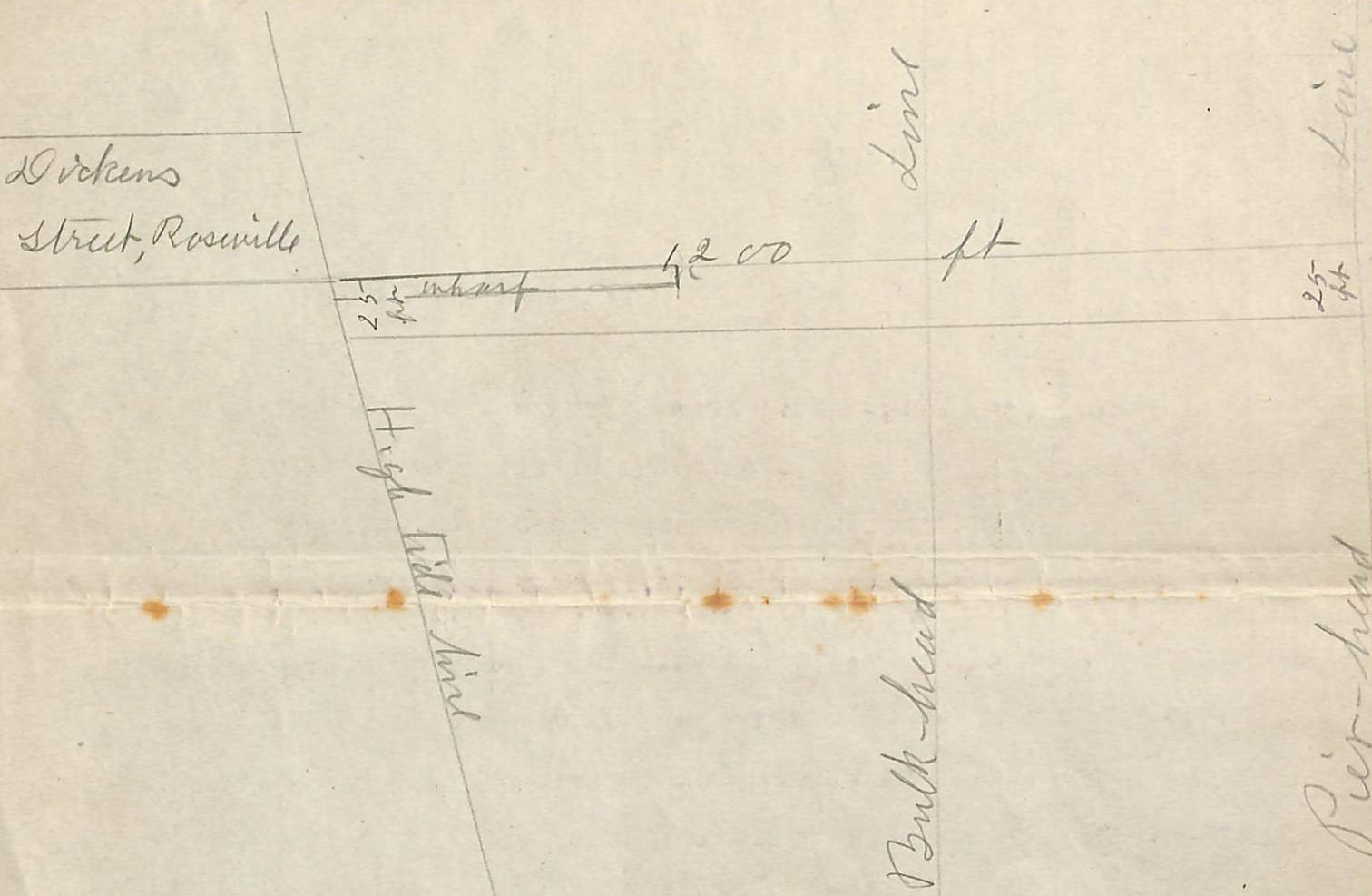
GENTLEMEN:

The undersigned respectfully petitions your Honorable Body as follows:

For a franchise for a wharf at Roseville; part of wharf is now built by permission of State Harbor Commission.

Starting at a point where the southerly line of Dickens street intersects the high tide line; thence southeasterly twelve hundred (1200) feet to the Pier head line; thence twenty-five (25) feet along the pier head line in a south-westerly direction; thence north-westerly twelve hundred (1200) feet to the line of high water; thence North-easterly along the line of high water twenty-five (25) feet to the point of beginning.
